This guide covers the steps for setting up printing using Android devices that are connected to the Murray Bridge High School BYOD network.

Install the Mobility Print app from the Google Play Store.	Mobility Print Paper Cut Software The productivity Similar Simplify printing from your Android device when using Paper Cut NG or Paper Cut MF
2. Launch the Mobility Print app .	Mobility Print PaperCut Software UNINSTALL OPEN 100 5.0 Productivity Similar Simplify printing from your Android device when using PaperCut MG or PaperCut MF
3. Tap Android Settings	Mobility Print for PaperCutMF & PaperCutMG How to print: In order to print you need to have configured your Mobility Print Server. 1. Go to Android Settings -> Printing. ANDROID SETTINGS 2. Tap Mobility Print. 3. Tap the enable toggle. 4. Exit out of Settings. 5. You are ready to print. When prompted enter your PaperCut username and password. The way you print is different depending on the app you want to print from. For more information, see the documentation for the app. When you select a printer, make sure you select a Mobility Print printer as identified by the PaperCut icon
